**Supplies Needed**

- 1/2 yard muslin
- 1/2 yard fabric (your choice)
- 1/2 yard contrast fabric (your choice)
- Fiberfill stuffing
- Disappearing pencil
- 1 DMC embroidery floss (red)
- Small paint brush
- Barnyard Red Paint (Folk-art brand)
- Sewing Supplies
- Turning Tool
- Sculpting Doll Needle
- Pinking Shears
- 2 - (1/2") Black buttons
- 2 - (1/2") daisy button
- Red yard (for hair)
- Garden Tools (optional)

**THE PRIMITIVE HUTCH**

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### **Abbreviated Words:**

RST= Right Sides Together

RSO= Right Sides Out

1/4" Seam allowance is added to piece

\*\*\*Read all directions thoroughly before getting started. Start by making a template of the pattern pieces. You can use heavy card stock paper or cardboard. \*\*\*\*

### **Directions**

Cut pattern pieces on double layer of muslin. Sew all pieces leaving opening where indicated on pattern. Clip curves, turn RSO. Stuff body firmly and whip stitch close. Stuff arms and legs to stuffing line indicated on pattern. Set arms aside.

Using a disappearing pencil, draw paint lines on legs (see pattern). Paint stripe areas barnyard red. Let dry. With toes facing each other, hand stitch legs to bottom of body. Hand stitch arms to body where indicated on pattern.

**Doll Head:** Cut 6 pieces on single layer of muslin. Sew each piece together one at a time. Sew last head piece to first head piece leaving opening to stuff. Turn RSO and stuff head firmly (it will look like a small pumpkin).

**Dress/Skirt:** Cut 1 bodice on double fold fabric. Cut neck opening to X indicated on bodice pattern. Open and lay flat with right side of bodice facing you.

Cut or tear 2 skirt pieces 6"w x 15"l. Sew a gathering stitch along 15" side of both skirt pieces. With right sides facing each other, line up one 15 inch skirt piece to fit within bodice piece. Stitch together. Do the same for the other skirt piece.

Place dress together with right sides facing each other. Sew under arm sleeves and down both sides of the dress. Turn RSO and place on doll.

Fold each sleeve cuff under 1/2" and sew a gathering stitch around the sleeve. Pull thread to close and knot off. Sew buttons on dress.

### **Attaching Head**

Place head onto neck of body. Hand stitch head in place. Continue to hand stitch until you feel the head is secure and it won't wobble.

**Eyes:** Enter at top of doll head and sew button eyes in place (see eye placement). Exit needle back at top of doll head and pull thread to give eyes a slight indentation. Knot off

**Nose/Mouth:** Outline nose onto head using a disappearing pencil. Using red DMC embroidery floss, enter at top of doll head and whip stitch nose until you get the shape you want. For the mouth I hand drew five small dashes with a disappearing pencil then I back stitched the mouth. Once you are done, exit needle at top of doll head. Knot off.

**Bloomers:** Cut 2 pieces 8" w x 10" l. on muslin. Sew each 10 inch side of bloomers. Cut 4 inches up the center of the bloomers. Sew around the 4 inch cut (sewing up one side and down the other side to form the legs). Turn RSO, and place bloomers on doll. Fold waist under 1/2 inch and sew a gathering stitch around the waist. Pull thread to close. Knot off. Fringe the bottom of bloomers with a little sand paper.

**Hair/Bow:** Cut 31 strands of doll hair (15" Long). Place one strand aside. Line up all the other strands evenly. Using the strand you set aside; tie the bunch together in the center. Hand sew hair to center of doll head.

**Bow:** Cut a 1" w x 16" l strip from a piece of fabric. Tie into a bow and hand stitch it to top of doll head.

**Apron:** Cut or tear one piece 6" w x 20" L on contrast fabric. Trim all edges of apron with pinking shears. Measure 1/2 inch down from top of 20 inch side of apron and sew a gathering stitch across leaving enough thread on both ends to pull together. Pull threads to tie around waist of doll and knot off.

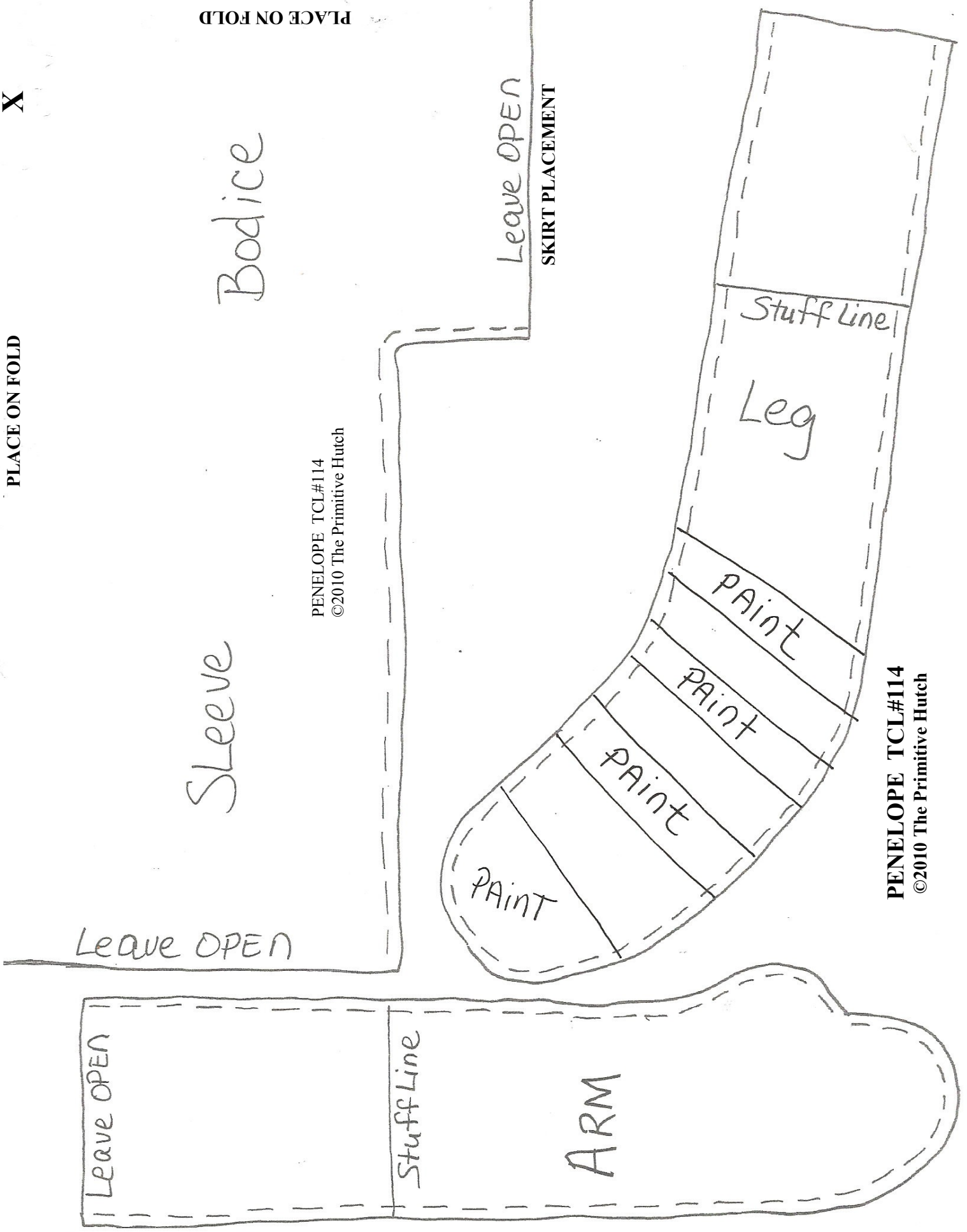

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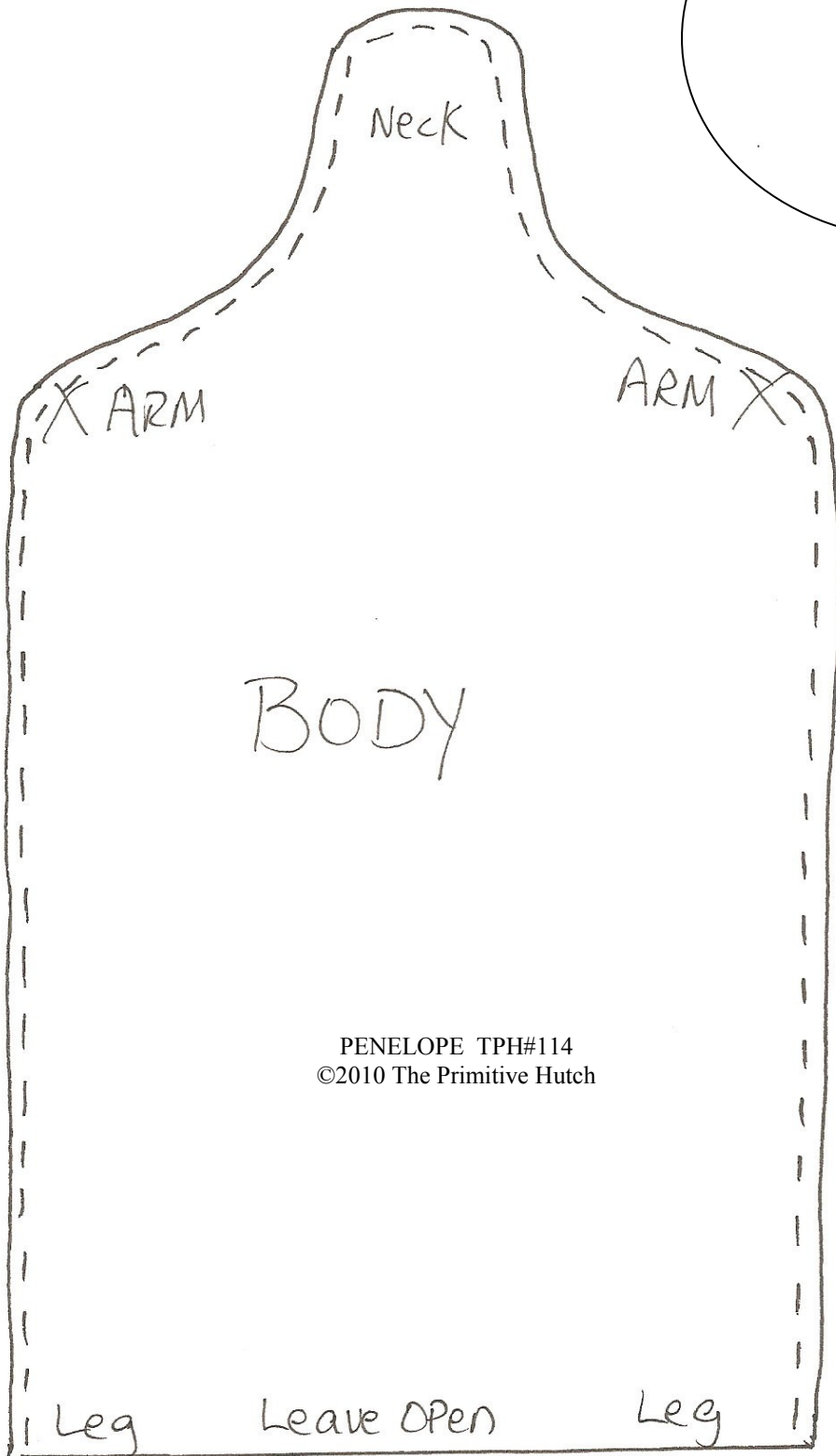
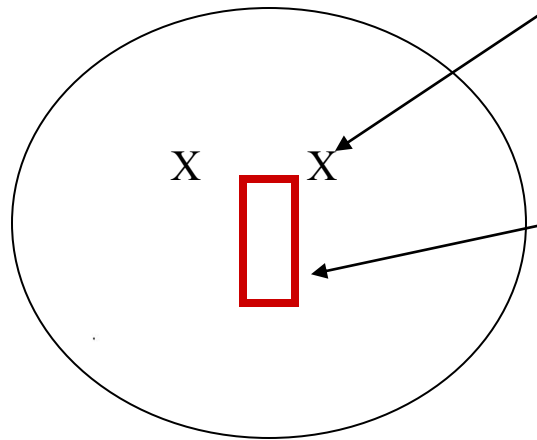
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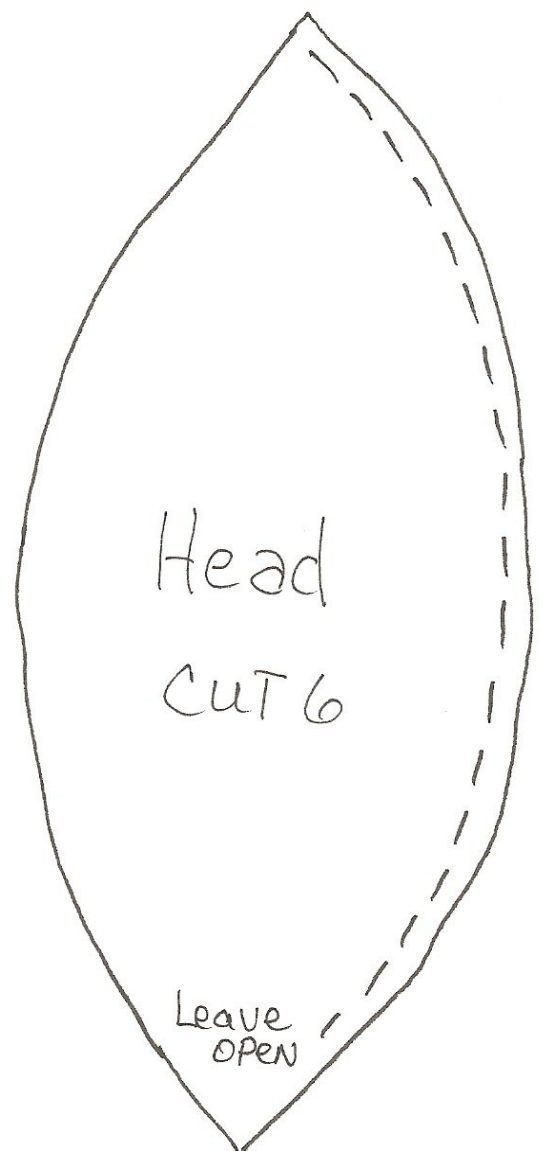
**FACE DIAGRAM**
